

Greetings and warm wishes for the up-coming festival season.

It is our privilege to avail the opportunity to serve you in our common interest of development of your ward, through our brain exercising programs being run with the support of our valued course instructor in your neighbourhood. Yet again, with your continued support and good wishes, we are organizing our Next NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP.

Though the location details about the venue and schedule time for the test will be informed separately through the respective teachers, forms will be made available at your centre during the months of September-October.

However, through this communication we wish to inform you of certain important dates and the prizes in this competition. Please note the following points as preliminary information to you. The important dates pertaining to the distribution and collection of forms, test, etc will be informed.

Levels for which test will be conducted are as below.

With Abacus: Junior Level 0 to Junior Level 6 and Senior Level 0 to Senior Level 8

Without Abacus: Junior Level 1 to Junior Level 6 and Senior Level 1 to Senior Level 8

Champion of Champions (Without Abacus only):

Junior Level 2 to Junior Level 6 and

Senior Level 2 to Senior Level 8

Vedic Maths: Level 0, 1, 2 and 3 Some more details are mentioned below.

Venue for championship :

Will be informed at the time of championship.

Eligibility: A student may appear for one level previous to the level the student has passed or is appearing for on or before one month of test date.

Participation Fees: will be informed at the time of championship.

The details of prizes that are distributed are as follows.

- (A) First, Second, Third and Consolation prizes / trophies for each level of Junior and Senior, in both with and without abacus category, separately and for Vedic Maths.
- (B) Consolation prizes are given to deserving students with high score and fast speed, even with age into consideration.
- (C) Contest for Champion of Champions is only in without abacus category. There are no consolation prizes for Champion of Champions in each category.
- (D) A participation certificate and medal is awarded to every student who scores 70% or above, but fails to win a trophy.
- (E) All students who score less than 70% are awarded with only a participation certificate.

Pattern of Question Papers:-

1. The pattern of questions in each level shall essentially be as per the sample paper.
2. However, number of questions "may be" more than the number of questions in the sample papers.
3. The only reason for this increase in the number of questions is because we do not want any student to complete the question paper.
4. As informed during various individual discussions or in a group, we do not want the scope of human error to affect the performance of a student. Hence, if many students complete the test paper before the stipulated time, there is a possibility of
 - (a) Overlapping sound of more than one student who complete the test,
 - (b) Minute difference in the actual time and time noted, a student takes to complete the test.

Hence, number of questions may be increased.

Duration of tests

- (a) With abacus - 15 minutes.
- (b) Without abacus - 15 minutes.
- (c) COC - 5 minutes.
- (d) Vedic Maths - 30 minutes.

Point of critical importance" ---

IN WITH ABACUS CATEGORY test, students should essentially attempt the test by use of abacus only. IF ANY STUDENT IS OBSERVED TO BE DOING A WITH ABACUS TEST MENTALLY / WITHOUT ABACUS, the invigilators will make a note of the same. Such test papers are subject to disqualification or negative marking. Invigilators decision will be binding and final.

1. Roll no. has three parts.
 - (a) First part is the level for which the student is appearing.
 - (b) The second part is an official code.
 - (c) The last part is individual's identity.
 - (d) Students should be advised to write only the last part of their roll no. on the question paper.
2. Students should carry their admit cards, pen / pencil, eraser, sharpener and abacus tool to the examination hall. (In case students do not carry abacus tool while appearing for 'with abacus' category, they may be disqualified.)
3. Gate pass should be retained with the parents, and should be handed over at the exit gate while picking up their ward.

In case of loss or absence of gate pass, parents have to furnish following details in writing.

Student name

Parent name

Centre location

Teacher name

Signature with date and time.

Students appearing for 'only without abacus category ' or 'both with and without abacus ' categories will be relieved 40 minutes after the commencement of their test.

All other students will be relieved 60 minutes after the commencement of their test.

Parents are not allowed inside the school premises.

We should neither be over excited nor be lenient to make a note of such a Cheating.
